

# WEATHER ALERT

**PM Update...**This afternoon, there is little change to the forecast as we're on the outer fringes of a coastal storm that lead to some areas of light snow. One main thing to stress is that the snow is slow to start and the best risk for accumulation likely comes in the pre-dawn / early morning. The evening and first half of the night feature possible snow showers and a lot more dry time than not. Overall, the snow should mainly be light and that will keep pavements variable in coverage since temps are at or slightly above freezing. The strong coastal low pressure is well east, thus keeping the heavier snow east. Still, a "better" snow can fall in eastern sections of our area and that gives parts of Middlesex County a chance for 1-2" (not all of that on pavements), while Mercer Co. and Southern Somerset are likely coating - 1". This light snow lingers into the morning tomorrow before fading away and we warm to the low 40s with partial sunshine.
