

WEATHER ALERT

PM Update... This afternoon, there is little change to the forecast as we'll see occasional areas of light snow try to move in for this evening. The snow may hug the shoreline and not be continuous for a good portion of the evening and early night. It is not until tomorrow morning (likely in the 2-5 AM timeframe) that the snow becomes more continuous. Overall, it is a light snow, but there will be a few periods where the snow gets moderate in intensity and that can allow some pavements to cover. Again, best chance for that should be in the pre-dawn and early morning tomorrow. While the heaviest snows look to be east, a slight shift in the coastal low track could push our area into higher totals. It's a slow end to the snow tomorrow morning, but once we get more daylight, it will be hard for any pavements to cover after 9-10 AM.
