

WEATHER ALERT

PM Update... Snow has settled well south of the area for the afternoon and still looks to remain there for the rest of the daytime. Start-time tonight remains difficult to pin down as that snow starts lifting northward, however it is fighting with dry air coming down for the Northeast. Thus, it will be a battle where spotty/occasional areas of flurries and light snow try to move in late evening through pre-dawn. Snow becomes much more likely 3-6 AM. Thereafter, it rapidly gets steady and any snow is probably brief as we go to sleet. Most of the predicted total is likely sleet and that is a good amount as more than a coating of sleet is dense and difficult to remove. Then it's over to rain later in the morning. Most should be above freezing, however, there are spots where it's possible to be 32 degrees, so there is the chance for brief ice. We'll keep warming through the afternoon and into Tuesday Night as rain continues.

Hazard	Threat	Description
Ice	Low	Can't rule out a few spots near 32 when precip changes to rain with patchy ice possible
Snowfall Rate	Moderate	A period of moderate to even heavy snow/sleet (mainly sleet) is likely tomorrow daybreak and morning.

Monday	Mostly cloudy and likely staying dry. High 34 - 37 NE 7 - 17 mph High Tide: 11:54 AM
Mon Night	Cloudy as intermittent and mainly light snow becomes possible 10 PM - 3 AM. More likely and steadier 3 - 6 AM as it mixes with sleet. Coating - 1.0" of Snow/Sleet Low 28 - 32 NE winds inc. to 15 - 25 mph High Tide: 12:17 AM
Tuesday	Snow/Sleet becomes mainly sleet not long after daybreak (falling steadily). This transitions to rain 9 AM - 12 PM, though some spots may still be 32 until 2 PM. 0.5 - 1.5" of Snow/Sleet (Storm Total, mainly sleet) Patchy Ice (AM) Temps in AM 29 - 33, PM: 35 - 40 ENE winds 15 - 30 mph, gusts to 40 High Tide: 12:46 PM
Tue Night	Persistent rain showers with some steadier periods of rain. The rain ends in the pre-dawn and it is windy at times. 0.40 - 0.80" of Rain Temps into 40s, a late low 37 - 42 Varying winds become West 10 - 25 mph late. High Tide: 1:09 AM
Wednesday	Windy and partly sunny. High in the mid 40s W winds 15 - 30 mph, gusts 40 - 45 High Tide: 1:44 PM
